- Promote individuals, groups or organisations that support terrorism.
- Spread hatred and intolerance.
- Discriminate against or harass any person or group on the grounds of their sex, race, nationality, ethnicity, disability, religious or other similar belief, sexual orientation, or age. Defame any person or organisation.
- Talk down or degrade any rival or competitor.
- Unrealistically make claims about the ability or quality of any product or service.
